Basic coffee pod machine, easy to use, makes hot and cold drinks, takes up very little space on the bench. Uses Nescafe Dolce Gusto pods, available online and from Coles, Woolworths and Harvey Norman for about \$8.50 for a box of either 8 or 16, depending on the variety. Pods are chosen by type of drink (Americano, cappuccino, hot chocolate etc) rather than strength, so strength cannot be easily customised. Special flavours are available at some times, including Nesquik, peach iced tea and chai. Milky varieties have powdered milk and sometimes sugar included in the pod.
